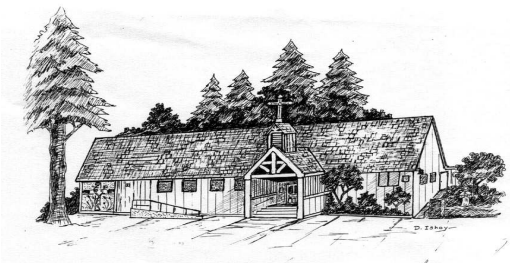

Dear St. Timothy's Church Family and Friends—

One of the interesting things that happens to me on occasion since I've become your vicar is that people I come across in the community ask me to pray for them or their loved ones. Most recently, a checker at a store asked me to pray for her mother who has breast cancer. The mother's name is Ellen and I hope that all of us will be praying for her.

My intention when I get a prayer request like the one for Ellen is to add the name to our intercessions book that we keep in the narthex. That book is the one we use during the "Prayers of the People" portion of our worship services. The problem is that I don't always remember to add the name when Sunday morning comes around. That doesn't mean that I forgot to pray for the person in need. I spend quite a bit of time during each day praying for people. But we put the names of people that need prayer in the intercessions book so that we can bring more people into the mix.

We are a church community that believes in the power of prayer. We feel that the people we pray for are strengthened by our intercessions. God hears our prayers and intervenes in powerful ways that does not always meet our expectations. And we often don't even get to know what the outcome of prayers will be.

I've been praying for a woman named Susan for almost a year now. Her mother, a person that I have known for decades, asked me to pray for

Susan. She has cancer too, although I can't remember which kind (and it doesn't matter anyway). I don't know how Susan is doing because I don't see her mom that often and Susan lives in some far away town. But, I continue to pray for her. People with cancer need all the prayer they can get.

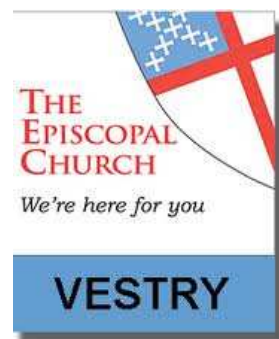
A woman named Claire asked me to pray for her children. One of her daughters lives in Grants Pass. It turns out that the daughter, Pam, attends St. Luke's Episcopal Church there. We all move in pretty small circles in God's world. And we are all bound together by what I have heard described as an invisible thread. I think that our prayers travel along this thread in a way similar to the way emails travel through the Internet. If the Internet is the "information superhighway" then the invisible thread is the "prayer supernatural highway."

It is a humbling thing to know that people are praying for you. Don't be afraid to let the people we are praying for know that they are in our prayers. I think that knowing you are being prayed for makes the prayers doubly healing. And there is no doubt in my mind that prayer heals.


